OVERVIEW

The community of Spanish Forks, UT had a need — an inclusive all-abilities park for everyone, regardless of their physical or developmental ability. A place where kids in a wheelchair could play alongside their friends and where a child with autism could interact with various sensory activities.

In September 2020, Spanish Forks got their wish when the Adventure Heights Park was unveiled on a 10+ acre piece of beautiful land with rolling mountains as the backdrop. The innovative park features a walking trail, sensory garden, zip line with a harness, an ADA-accessible splash pad, treehouse, wheel-chair accessible swings, pavilions, different types of slides, hands-on activities, a faux "gold mine", and more! Local families with kids who have special needs provided input on the park's design and various features — making this project even more special for the community.

The designers knew they needed a surfacing material that was safe for these families.
